Its roots lie in ASA Bangladesh, founded in 1978, which developed a successful specific microfinance model that is being replicated by the various subsidiaries worldwide.

ASA Kenya was launched in 2013 and currently has branches in six counties, serving more than 27,000 women micro-entrepreneurs. The institution has plans to expand national coverage and increase its focus on rural areas.

ASA Kenya Limited has been an Oikocredit partner since 2017.
